Sun requirements:

Position:

- ML – Moisture loving (damp site preferred)
- SAq – Semi-aquatic (wetland edges, boggy garden sites)
- Aq – Aquatic (partly submerged in shallow ponds or dams)
- ST – Salt tolerant (tolerates salt spray exposure and saline sites)
- DT – Drought tolerant (tolerates periods of dryness once established)

Soil Type:

- S – Sandy soils
- L – Loam soils
- H – Heavy soils (i.e. clay)
- A – All soil types

Notes

- This is not a comprehensive list of the indigenous plants of Phillip Island.
- Height, flowering time, habit and position requirements are included in this list as a guide only.
- Growth patterns will differ due to the natural variations of individual plants and the specific conditions to which they are exposed.
- Not all of these plants are always available. Some plants may need to be ordered in advance to ensure supply.
- Minimum tubes orders are 100 tubes.
- Tube orders are generally taken in September, October, December, to allow sufficient growing time. (eight months minimum, indigenous plants take from 6-24months growing time, including hardening off, and seasonal variation).
- Orders taken year round (please read note above)
