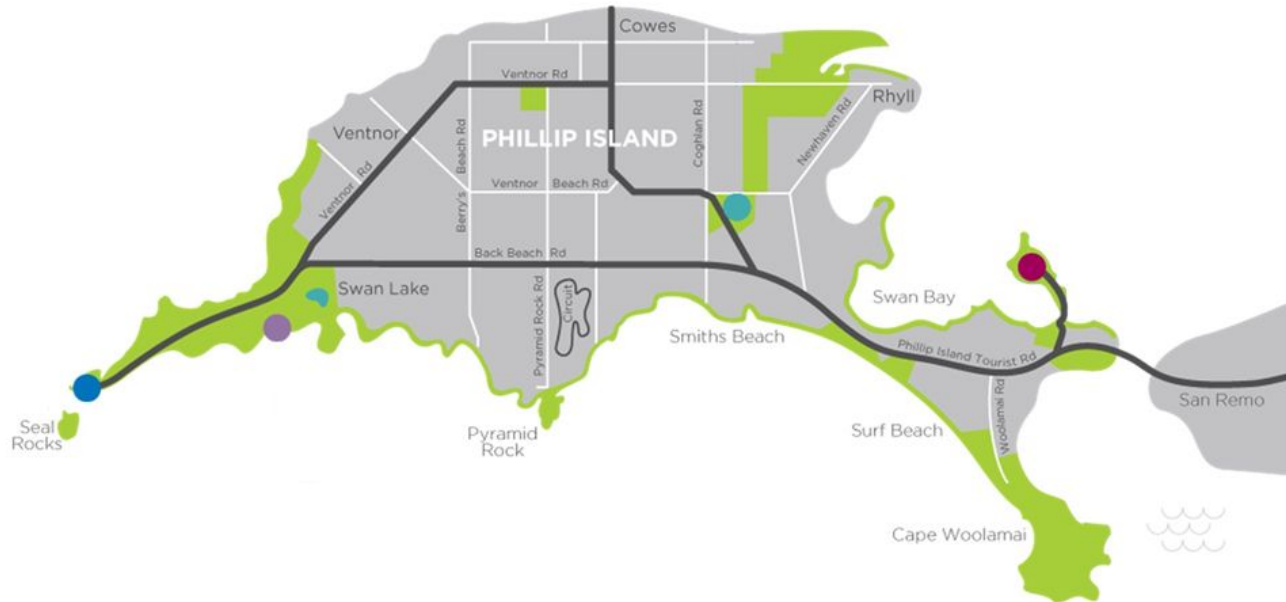

In the last 500 years, human activity has forced over **800 species** into extinction.

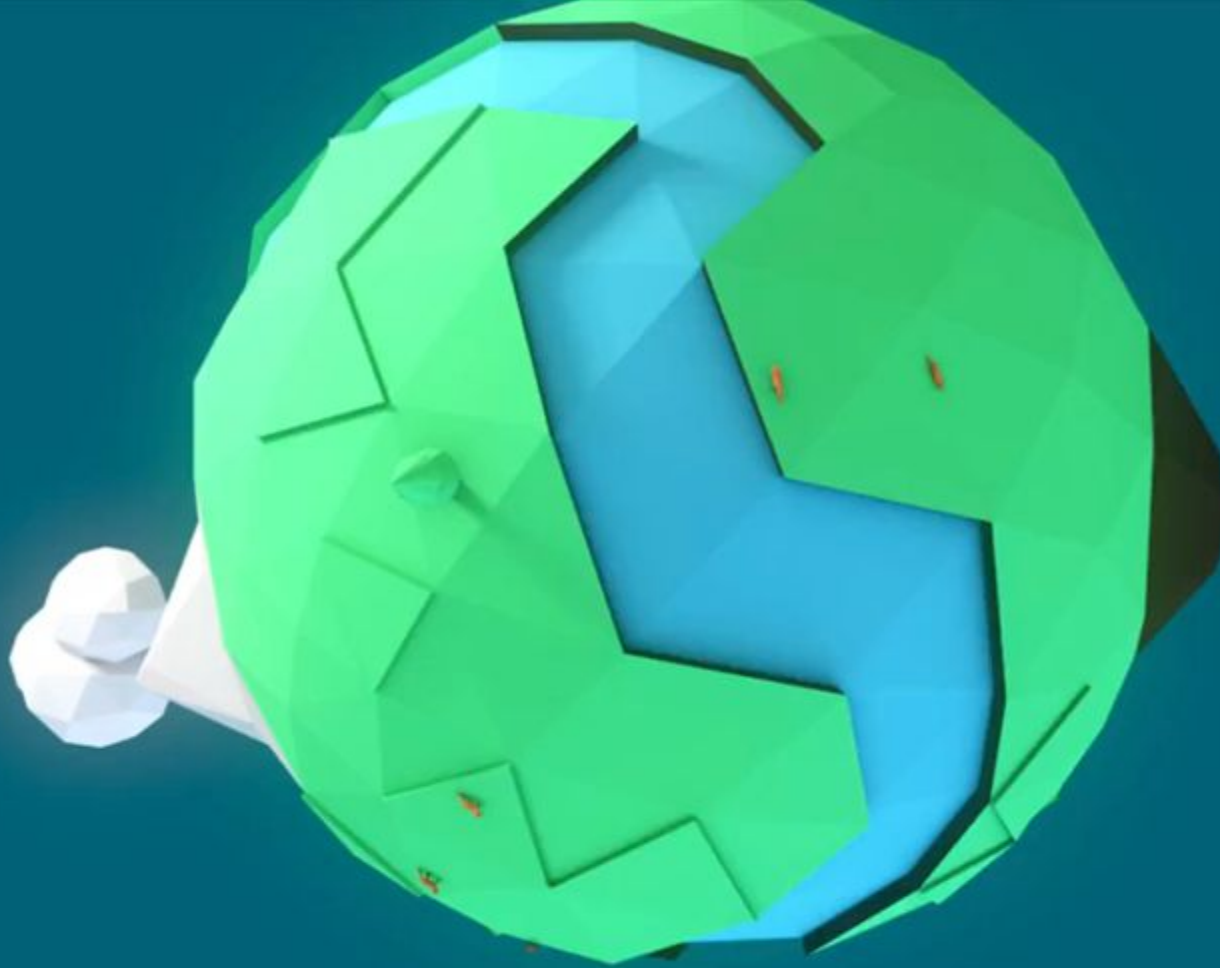
